Trembling and Bewildered

"Trembling and bewildered, the women went out and fled from the tomb. They said nothing to anyone, because they were afraid." Mark 16:8

Joy, happiness and enthusiasm are probably some of the first words we would use to describe Easter Morning. One of the last words we would use is fear. It is just not a word that we would associate with Easter, but there it is in black and white in Mark 16:8 "*Trembling and bewildered, the women went out and fled from the tomb. They said nothing to anyone, because they were afraid.*" These women were afraid despite the fact that the angels tried to comfort them and had told them that Jesus had risen from the dead. According to Mark, the women's fear did not turn to joy even when they heard the message. They're fear was of the unknown. At least when Jesus was dead, they knew what to expect. The empty tomb turns their whole world upside down. They have yet to see Jesus, so they live in the fear of the in between. They live in that twilight just before dawn, "saying nothing to anyone because they were afraid."

We often live in that same twilight. We've experienced the Resurrection. It has turned our world upside down. We have faith. Jesus is our friend. We pray. Yet at the same time we have our doubts. We hear and see people who scoff at the Christian faith, or we look around our world and see so much suffering and we wonder why. We struggle at times with our thoughts and attitudes and we worry about the future. We are tempted to respond like those women who saw the empty tomb. We think it might be best to just keep quiet about our faith.

The good news is that the Resurrection doesn't depend on our lack of doubts. Jesus rose from the dead not because the women or the other disciples had enough faith. They did not, that much is obvious. Jesus rose from the dead because of God's power and authority. It is the same with us. Our faith doesn't depend on banishing all doubt and fear. No, again, our faith depends on the power of God. We are God's children not because we are good enough, but rather because God adopted us. The Easter message is that there is nothing that could stop Jesus' resurrection: not evil, not cruelty, not death and certainly not our doubts.

During the Easter season, in April and May, we will be looking at the different resurrection appearances and what they mean for our faith and life in the here and now. The sermon series title is **Resurrection Now!** I hope you will join us!

<u>Adult Offerings during the Education Hour FOR YOUR FAMILY:</u> Each Sunday at 9:15 Discover Church has high quality, Biblical teachings for all ages including adults. On April 23rd Stephanie Rossing LMFT will talk about "Family Short Circuits" with a follow up, practical discussion on April 30th. On May 7th Dr. Melissa Mork will be discussing "Parenting Styles and Life" and on May 14th she will be discussing "Marriage Peace and Conflict." Children's Offerings during the Education Hour

- Nursery (6 wks to Age 3) A warm, caring environment with experienced teachers who play with and encourage your child.
- 3's Class: Foundational Bible stories are taught, children enjoy a puppet show and get age appropriate play with other children their age. Taught by the same teachers every week with familiar helpers.
- Age 4-Kindergarten: Foundational Bible stories, age appropriate object lessons, activities and crafts. Taught by very qualified, caring, fun teachers who understand the joy of being a child!
- Girl's 1st & 2nd Grade: Age appropriate relational Bible lessons, crafts and object lessons taught in a caring, safe and loving environment. Taught by the same caring teacher each week.
- Boy's 1st & 2nd Grade: Boys learn the "Heroes of the Faith" and have a time of active play and object lessons. They have opportunities to be mentored by two weekly teachers that build confidence in problem solving and expressing their faith.
- Combined 3rd & 4th Grade: Bible lessons that gear toward practical expressions of their faith are taught. Object lessons, crafts and time to play with age mates from our church are a weekly goal.
- Boys' 5th & 6th grade: In depth Bible lessons are taught by veteran teachers who relate very well with boys of this age.
- Girls' 5th & 6th grade: Relational Bible lessons with practical elements on how faith expresses itself in today's world is taught by 2 veteran teachers who relate very well with our girls!

Great Salvation Institute (GSI) for Grades 1 through 6: The GSI prize cart will always be out on the 3rd Sundays of the month! Your child should be receiving weekly updates telling them how many points they have to spend toward prizes. If you are not aware, there are sermon questions made available at the "Busy Bag Buffet" located in the foyer. Each week children have the chance to answer 5 questions about the sermon that will earn them up to 5 points a week.

Palm Sunday and Easter Services: The children will be waving palms and shouting "Hosanna!" at both services on Palm Sunday, April 9. Children ages 3 to 6th grade will need to arrive at 8:20am. We will feed them breakfast and keep them busy until they sing in the 2nd service. Easter Services will be at 8:00am, 9:30am & 11:00am and we invite our kids to join us! There will be no childcare during the 8:00am service, but there will be childcare for ages 5 and under available during the 9:30am and 11:00am services. This is a PERFECT day to invite friends and family! All children will receive special bags full of things to keep them busy, and to take home as gifts from Discover.

Vacation Bible School: We have set the date for VBS! It will be held August 14-18 from 9 am to Noon. This is available for Children age 4 through 6th Grade. Cost and further information will be available soon. Please contact Christy Grigor if you would be able to help with VBS.

10:30 Family Service Childcare: Each Sunday during the Family Service we have around 10-15 children who are checked into childcare. Please consider serving as a helper for this MINISTRY!
