You are probably reading this after Thanksgiving and at the beginning of Advent. More importantly, you are reading this just as the frenetic activity of the holiday seasons begins. Let me state up front that I love this time of year. I love the seasonal music (both religious and secular) and the decorations. I love shopping for gifts for love ones and receiving gifts from them. I love the big meals and special treats. I the stories and traditions that have grown up around these two holidays. It truly can be a wonderful time of year.

If we are not careful, however, we can let the trappings of the season: food, decorations, shopping, special parties, and presents, obscure the heart of both Thanksgiving and Christmas. Thankfulness can be both an antidote to that feeling of frustration and anxiety as well as comfort in times of loneliness. Make room in your schedule to fellowship with God. Take time to thank our Father for all the good gifts He has showered on us. Think about all of those things in your life that are true, noble, right, pure, lovely and admirable. Take time to think about them to thank the Lord for them and to trust that God will see you through any present need. Indeed, the Bible is right – if we take that time to remember God's gifts and trust God for our needs the peace of God which transcends all understanding will guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

I bring you greetings in the matchless name of our Savior, Jesus of Nazareth.

By the time you read this newsletter, Thanksgiving Day will have come and gone. I do hope you had opportunities to pause and give thanks to the Lord for His love, mercy and graciousness as you gathered and celebrated with family and friends from both near and far. The last Sunday of the Church year (the Sunday after Thanksgiving day) is known as Christ the King Sunday. We look forward to the start of a new church year to be ushered in by the first Sunday of Advent, on Sunday, December 3rd.

#### NEW OPPORTUNITIES FOR CHILDREN DURING THE 10:30AM FAMILY SERVICE

#### Childcare for children up to age 5:

During this service childcare is offered for babies 3 months old to children age 5. This is located in the last classroom on the right of the Education wing. You can check your child in at the beginning of the service, or after the Children's Ministry Sermon!

The impact of Hurricane Harvey is extensive. Thousands of homes have water damage, over 30,000 people have been displaced, businesses and schools have been effected as well.
