# From Pastor Carl's Desk

### The Challenge

The past year has been a good year in many ways: multiple baptisms, new members joining, good ministry done in partnership with Hospitality House, Families Moving Forward, Feed My Starving Children and other organizations, the re-launch of our Life Groups and the growth of the mid-week Bible study. We could add wonderful times of fellowship, meaningful experiences of praise and worship, life changing testimonies and much more.

It has, however, been a difficult year financially. As we reached the end of the year it was obvious that significant reductions needed to be made to the 2018 budget and because the budget committee worked so hard in 2016 to trim fat from the 2017 budget the significant changes were going to have to come from the staff portion of the budget. I worked with an ad hoc committee to make suggestion to council on how to proceed. We were facing some grim choices. That is why I am grateful to Pastor La for volunteering to temporarily reduce his position to half-time. With Pastor La's sacrifice we were able to make several smaller reductions to bring the 2018 budget in line with our current income levels.

The key here is that we want Pastor La's half-time status to be <u>temporary!</u> We want to bring Pastor La back to full-time status as soon as possible. That is our challenge for 2018. How do we go about doing that? We need to set a goal and work toward meeting it. For Pastor La to come back to full-time status we need to average \$17,499 per week. That was the weekly income amount needed to meet the 2017 budget. We are currently averaging about \$16,500 per week. Now I know that many of you have given above and beyond, and we are extremely grateful, but if we could not make the \$17,499 in 2017 how are we going to reach that goal in 2018?

Here are several important ideas on how we can reach this goal:

- Continue to invite people to discover their full life in Christ. As we continue to grow as a congregation our financial resources will also grow. It's important that we keep our priorities straight. We invite so that people might know Jesus, not to help with our budget. A happy byproduct though is that our income grows.
- **Develop separate income streams outside regular offerings.** The staff is already working on some possible income streams. One simple one that is already in place is *Amazon Smile*. When you use this program a portion of your purchases on Amazon are given to the church. Further instructions on how to do this are listed on page 9 of this newsletter.
- Focus on the General Budget. It is fun to give to a special ministry. My wife Pam and I have done it often in the past. However, I want to encourage all of us to focus on general fund giving rather than designated funds until we are able to move past this temporary setback.
- Increase tithing. If you are not a tither take another step towards tithing.

In the months ahead, the council will be working on more steps to bring Pastor La back to full-time status. We are also planning to have some "listening posts" in January prior to the annual meeting for you to ask questions and share input with council members and Pastor Carl. The dates and details of these meetings are still being finalized. Watch for more information to come after the first of the year.

The most important step is to continue to pray. We are still in the midst of our Gideon Moment and God will continue to be with us in this moment. If we take time to listen and pray, He will teach us and comfort us. He will lead us through this financial valley to brighter days and significant ministry ahead.

### From Pastor La's Desk Pastor La Andriamihaja



Dear Discover Church Family,

Please know that I decided on this course of action with the best interest of our congregation at heart – in order to reach a workable budget for 2018. Yes, I am convinced that God still has great plans and opportunities for us to be his hands and feet in the community, if not in the world, so that all people may discover their full life in Christ. Let's carry on!

Secondly, I want to thank all our Afrikan brothers and sisters at Discover Church who were involved in the success of our Afrikan Krismas Night, on Saturday, December 16<sup>th</sup>. 
