From Pastor Carl's Desk

Psalm 105:5-6

Remember the wonders (God) has done, His miracles, and the judgments He pronounced, you his servants, the descendants of Abraham, his chosen ones, the children of Jacob.

I have recently gotten excited about tracing my family tree. A couple years ago Barb Horn gave me a wonderful gift of doing a substantial amount of work on my family tree. She was able to trace portions of my tree back to colonial days. I was surprised and shocked. I thought ninety percent of my ancestors were immigrants that immigrated in the late nineteenth century. I have been fascinated by the brief stories that I have learned about my ancestors, as well as discovering where my roots lie. I always thought I was mostly, eighty percent, German ancestry. The truth is that my ancestry is as much English as it is German with some French and Scottish thrown in.

One of the reasons I have enjoyed this process is that it is a way to understand who you are and where you come from. Genealogy in general is a way to remember who we are.

While our ancestry can give us hints of who we are, a more important identity is that of a child of God. It is that identity that will remain forever, while our identity reveled in our ancestry will at some point crumble into dust. We should remember the promises that God has given us as well as the things that God has done for us in the past. It is that relationship as God's child that is of primary importance.

This summer we are going to celebrate that personal relationship as God's children. The celebration will occur at our last outdoor service. We will have our Baptismal Pool set up. There will be an opportunity for anyone who wants to be baptized for the first time to do just that. There will also be an opportunity for those who want to remember their baptism. In other words, to remind themselves of God's promises as well as what God has done for them in the past.

From Pastor La's Desk Pastor La Andriamihaja





Last month I wrote about and preached on how proud I am of this congregation in our collaborative efforts to end homelessness in the Metro Areas. Within the last 5 years, as a congregation in Mission for Christ, we have partnered with Beacon Interfaith Housing Collaborative and have collaborated with over 80 congregations across Hennepin and Carver counties to end homelessness. Thus far, our role in ending homelessness have been with Families Moving Froward (FMF) – a Beacon program that pro-

vide shelters for families experiencing homelessness by having congregations open their church buildings to these families, for a week at a time. But not only that, every family that goes through the FMF program is helped, mentored and equipped to find and move into stable housing. To date, Discover Church have welcomed, hosted and sheltered close to 100 people in our building and close to 80% of them have moved into affordable and stable housings. To those families, we've helped end their homelessness, and I am proud and thankful to our hearts and passion as a congregation.

That said, there are still over 6,000 individuals in our Metro Areas who experience homelessness EVERY night. This means, homelessness is still a reality in our midst, even out in the suburbs. That is why on Sun., June 11th, I encouraged and invited many of you to consider, to pray and to sign up to lend a hand to help with upcoming FMF hosting weeks. I am thankful to the 30-some of you who've stepped up and expressed your passion to help end homelessness in our communities. To them, I want to say, Thank You! You will receive an invitation in the near future inviting you to attend an important orientation and planning meeting regarding future FMF hosting weeks. If you have not signed up it, and would like to join us in ending homelessness, please feel free to talk to Staci Kruse, a Church Council member, or to me and one of us will make sure you're connected in.

Again, I thank our God for your passion, faithfulness and commitment as a congregation in ending homelessness in our Metro Areas. It' what Jesus asks of his followers to do, for the "least of these."

Happy are those who reside in your house, who praise you continually.


