Values, Vision, & Mission

This month's Newsletter article is being co-written by Pastor La and Pastor Carl. Earlier this summer, we met weekly for lunch to pray and talk about Discover Church's Values, Vision and Mission and how all three of them impact the future ministry of Discover Church. In this newsletter, we are going to briefly address each one of these important areas.

Our foundation is our Discover Church values. As many of you know they spell out the word "discover." While this is a helpful memory tool, it is not just a cute trick. Our values are what we believe and value most as a community in Christ. They help define our vision and mission. In other words, our vision and mission are born out of who we are in Christ. Since we have talked a great deal about our values in the past, we are simply going to mention them in this newsletter. They are: **D**iscipleship is a priority, **I**nspired by the living word, **S**pirit charged, **C**ulture of forgiveness, **O**rdinary people serving an extraordinary God, **V**ision for world mission, **E**thnically diverse, and **R**ooted in our communities and **R**eaching out. It is these values that set the boundaries and define who we are as a congregation in the Kingdom of God.

Let's move on to the vision that we believe comes from the Holy Spirit. Let's begin with a clear understanding as to what a "vision" is, for without a clear vision the "mission" will unravel (Prov. 29:18). To put it in the simplest way possible, a vision statement is one that answers the question: "As a congregation, what is our hope for the world?" It's a big, wide and broad question, but that's what "vision" is. So, for Discover Church, our hope for the world is that everyone on earth will come to "Believe in the Triune God, Belong to the Body of Christ, and Bless one another and God's creation." So in a nutshell, our congregational vision is three words, "Believe, Belong, Bless," short, clear and easy to remember.

The mission of Discover Church is the strategy to accomplish the vision that God has given us. Now that we're clear on what our hope for the world is (vision), how we're going to accomplish and achieve such a vision is our "mission," which is to "invite all people to discover their full life in Christ." The mission is to invite all people to join and to belong among us as people of God, so they may come to know, to believe and to be in a right relationship with the Triune God, so that they may bless others, wherever and however they are led by the Holy Spirit. It is important to know that this mission is for the congregation as a whole, but it is also for each believer and member of the Body of Christ. Therefore, it is not just the pastors, the staff or the Church Council members who are to carry out this mission, but all believers in the resurrected Jesus, the Son of God.

Another part of our mission is the short-term tactics or methodology that we employ to accomplish our mission to live out our vision. In developing our methodology, we again turn to those three words: believe belong, and bless. Two prongs comprise the believe/belong/bless tactics, one large and one small. First large, as a congregation we want to have large events that give participants a chance to believe, belong, and/or bless. Every large event should focus on one of these three areas. These three areas are of equal significance, so it is important to maintain a balance between all three within the congregation. What is true for the congregation is also true for the individual Christian life. Each believer should have a balance between believing: learning to trust in Jesus, belonging: fellowshiping with other believers in Jesus name and blessing: sharing the love of Jesus with those who don't yet know his love.

That is where the second prong of believe/belong/bless tactics is applied. Our Life Groups are places where individual believers get a chance to believe, belong and bless in a small group setting. It is a time to gather together and support one another in the faith (belong), to study God's word (believe) and to serve the community (bless). As we believe, belong and bless, we begin to discover our full life in Christ at the same time inviting others to start (or continue) to find their full life in Christ.

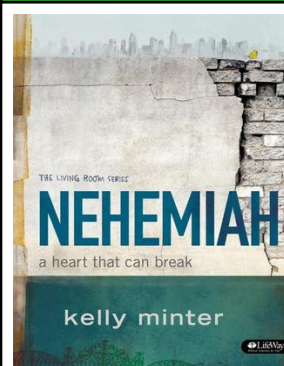
They are looking for volunteers from local congregations to help in many areas. Volunteer needs are:

With the beginning of fall here, I want to take this opportunity to thank everyone for their faithful support of our ministry and to give you an update on our current financial situation. Back in May we launched our “City on a Hill” Summer Bills program to help offset annual summer slump, when giving drops but the financial needs of the church remain the same. We set a goal to raise \$16,000 by the end of September to help us meet our summer expenses. We have already received over \$15,500 of that goal! Thank you for your generosity in making this happen.

While our summer bills campaign has been great a success, our general giving has dropped even more than expected this summer. As of the end of August, we have a deficit of \$47,598. While we anticipate giving to “bounce back” this fall as people return to church from summer travel and activities, we do have an immediate need to close the gap. That \$47,598 shortfall is a daunting number, but I want to assure you that the staff and council are continuing to work to find ways to cut expenses without impacting the needs of our ministries.

There are two ways that you can help.

- First, please pray for the ministry of Discover Church to continue to be a shining “city on a hill” to our members, our community and the world despite our budget deficit. Please pray for wisdom and discernment for the staff and leadership as we look at options to close that gap without sacrificing ministry needs.
- Second, in mid-August, we sent updated giving statements to anyone who had given thus far in 2017. Please let me know if you have any questions regarding your statement. If you’ve fallen behind on your giving more than you intended to this summer, please consider giving an extra offering to help catch up and reduce the deficit. If you haven’t fallen behind this summer, please prayerfully consider if you can make an extra donation at this time to help reduce the deficit.
